### **Some Other Events Celebrated :**

#### **Observance of International Youth Day:**

On 12<sup>th</sup> August 2023, International Youth Day was observed in our college. The theme of these year's Day was "Green Skills for Youth: Towards a Sustainable World. In this occasion a meeting was held and the role of youths and their power and capacity in making any positive and creative thing was discussed. The students were made aware of their potentiality, vigor and capacity to save the world from pollution, global warming and terrorism.

#### **Celebration of teacher's day:**

As previous years, this year also the students' union and other students of the all the department took an initiative to celebrate the teacher's day on 5<sup>th</sup> Sep with great enthusiasm which is also the birth anniversary of Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan. The celebration was started with a welcome speech by the general secretary of our college. Then the students felicitated all the teachers of the departments with a gamocha to honor and showcase respects towards all the teachers for their contribution in the field of education. After that the students also organized a cultural programme for the teachers where many of the students showed their vibrant skills and talents by singing, dancing, portraying drama and so on. Also they organized a fun game and activities for the teachers where they had to show their inner talents by singing, dancing, mimicking etc. Along with that the students of the other department also organized teachers' day for their teachers. At last the programme was concluded with a vote of thanks by the vice president of union body to present at the event.

#### **Faculty Exchange Programme:**

The department of Assamese, Birjhora Kanya Mahavidyalaya conducted a successful faculty exchange programme with Birjhora Mahavidyalaya to foster academic collaboration and knowledge sharing. Under this initiative Faculty member of the department of Assamese, Mrs. Banita Ray, Asstt. Professor Birjhora kanya Mahavidyalaya delivered lectures on Assamese literature, culture, and communication skills in the Assamese language. The faculty members of both institutions participated in the programme to explore innovative teaching methods and interdisciplinary research opportunities. Moreover, the programme was found to be effective in strengthening ties between the two institutes.

#### **Nature Tour to Hohanuwa:**

A one day nature tour was organized by the department of Assamese to Hohanuwa, Goalpara District on 31<sup>st</sup> Dec,2023. The aim of the tour was to provide students with a hands on learning experience about the biodiversity of our nature and vibrant cultures & promote environmental awareness. Altogether 40 students and different faculty members of other department have joined in the tour where they explored the scenic landscape, interacted with local communities to understand sustainable practices and engage in activities like photography and so on. Also a

session on biodiversity conservation by a local expert was a highlight of the tour. The tour was an educational as well as experiential one, where the students were encouraged to participate and practice such preservation of nature so that they can emphasize on sustainable practices in everyday life.

#### **Extension Activity by Deptt. of Education:**

The Department of Education organized an Awareness campaign among the tea garden labourers on 12th Dec 2023. The programme aimed at developing awareness to Eradicate Superstition and Prejudices among Tea garden labourers. The programme started with a rally from the college to the tea estate. After that the team visited door to door and addressed some issues such as irrational practices regarding superstitions & prejudices were discussed to aware them how these practices affects human being. The students also delivered speech on eradicating the superstitious beliefs and prejudices. The programme was found to be effective where both the tea tribe and students. The tea garden labourers especially women were able to know the ill effects of such practices which help them in eradicating the superstitious beliefs and prejudices. The programme was found effective as the students could convince the women labourers about the myth and facts of many superstitious beleif and prejudices.

#### **Observance of World Mental Health Day:**

An extension activity was organized on 10th Oct 2023 to observe the world mental health day. The activity was held at Nevard mental health hospital, Old civil hospital campus Bongaigaon. As mentioned above that the main objective of the activity was to make the students know about the importance of mental health and the consequences of mental illness so that the students could be aware of it. The activity was started by the HOD interacting with the patients and then the in-charge of mental hospital shared some experiences of how they treated the patients and how they dealt or cope with the patients. The faculty members and the students of the department also discussed about the importance of mental health. It was also discussed that how one should maintain mental hygiene and keep mental health balanced with physical health. Some of the patients who were healing also shared their experiences of being mentally ill. Later the students danced and sang songs to make the patients feel joyful where the patients also joined and enjoyed. At last snacks were served among all the participants.

#### **Observance of National Voters' Day:**

On January 25th 2024 the department of political science of Birjhora Kanya Mahavidyalaya in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organised in Bongaigaon district two raise awareness about voting rights and the importance of voters participation. The rally was aimed at educating the local community especially the youth about the significance of casting their votes in elections and making informed choices. Students and faculty members participated enthusiastically marching through the streets of Bongaigaon with banners and placards highlighting voters education messages. The rally also aimed to dispel common myths about about voting and encourage eligible voters, particularly first time voters to exercise their democratic rights. At the end of the session, there was an interaction between the students and the faculties which led to a proper understanding of the topic.
